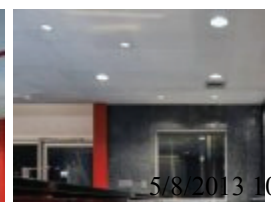
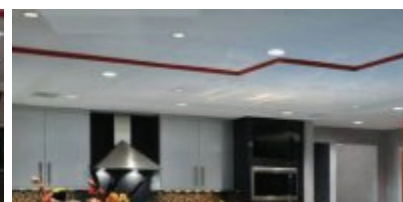
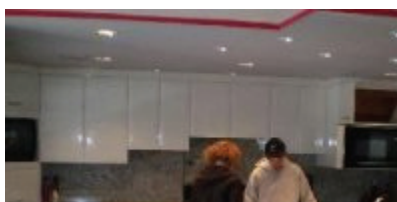


John Starck Designs Modern Art Glass Kitchen
